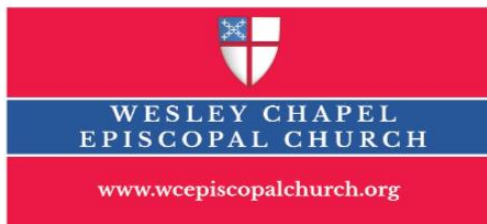

*****PLEASE REVIEW PRIOR TO ATTENDING SUNDAY EUCHARIST*****

Our 10:30 a.m. service observes safe distancing. Attendance at each service is limited to 25 people in the pews. This limit is based on our Bishop's letter requiring us to adhere to 25% of maximum occupancy and 6 feet of physical distancing. The following is designed to minimize contact between family units.

What we need from you:

- Do not come if you have any symptoms of Coronavirus.
- Please bring your own mask. Masks will be required to be properly worn (covering mouth and nose) before entering the church building. Please put on your mask in the car or before you approach the building. Do not approach the greeters without a mask on.
- Please do not arrive more than 10-15 minutes before the service.

WCEC In-person Worship Guidelines (cont.)

- Remain 6 feet away from other family units as you approach the church, as well as inside the building.
- Please proceed directly into the Sanctuary. Do not stop or gather in the narthex.
- Hand sanitizer is available in the Narthex for your use. While you are in this environment please do not touch your face and make sure you wash your hands properly.

Procedure:

- Please exit your cars while keeping social distancing of 6 feet from other family units entering the church.
- As you approach the sanctuary doors follow the directions of an usher to designated seated areas.
- Offertory collection plates will not be passed; their locations will be announced and pointed out at the service.
- There will be no Books available (Book of Common Prayer, Hymnal). Please bring your own BCP and/or Bible. At the end of the service, do not leave any personal items in the pews.
- The Peace will be given by a wave or bow with reverence. There will be no physical contact.
- During Communion only the bread will be offered. Please use the center aisle and maintain 6 feet between each person.
- During Communion, keep your mask on. Once you are seated you may consume the bread. Replace the mask immediately after consuming the bread.
- When the service has concluded, please go directly to your car, do not stop or gather in the narthex, bell tower or parking lot. Remember to maintain 6 feet away from other family units.
- There is no beverage service and no breakfast ministry until further notice
